### IS GROOMING AND CLIPPING THE SAME THING?

It is easy to become confused about the difference between grooming and clipping. "Grooming" refers to a variety of procedures that are associated with a grooming salon. Nail clipping, ear plucking, brushing out, bathing, clipping the coat, parasite treatments etc. Whereas clipping on its own generally refers to the process done to dogs with continuous hair growth and is considered as only one step in the grooming process.
